VOTERS INFORMATION

1.0 A person is entitled to be an elector at an election held during the SCCC General Election if on voting day, he or she:

- A current member of the SCCC
- is a Canadian citizen; or a Landed Immigrant,
- is at least 18 years old; and,
- is not prohibited from voting of otherwise by law.
- Members who are in position of valid SCCC card

2.0 Voters' List

Copies of the Voters' List are available for all members viewing at the SCCC, or can be provided via e-mail, or regular post upon request. The list will also be found during Election Day (Sunday March 23rd, 2008). All current members who meet the criteria in Para (1.0) are qualified to vote.

3.0 Proxy Voting:

If you are unable to vote on Election Day (Sunday March 23rd, 2008), you can appoint a voting proxy to vote on your behalf.

*Under Section () of the **SCCC By-Laws, 2003**, an elector may act on behalf of one other qualified elector who is not a relative **or** on behalf of one or more qualified electors who are relatives. In the case where an elector is acting on behalf of more than one qualified electors who are relatives, separate proxy forms are required. A relative means the parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, brother, sister, spouse, or same-sex partner of the elector appointed. An elector can only vote as a proxy for one non-relative.*

Appointment of Proxy Forms will be posted at www.syriatoday.ca available to all current members of the SCCC, or can be picked from the SCCC at: **7370-14 Bramalea Rd. Mississauga, Ontario L5S 1N6.**

The form must be completed as follows:

- The elector making the appointment of proxy must complete the form identifying himself/herself and the individual being appointed to vote on the elector's behalf and to attest to their relationship
- The SCCC Election Committee will proceed during the Election Day, in compiling all proxies, and verified them against all memberships list, before allowing for elector to vote.
- After the form has been certified, the original copy will be returned to the elector appointed to be taken to the voting place to receive the proxy ballot.

***Reminder:** The deadline for submitting an Appointment of Voting Proxy form is **March 22nd, 2008.**
